



**PEGNL presents *Geoscience Hunt* - a virtual scavenger hunt for all students in Newfoundland & Labrador**

For the first year ever PEGNL will host a virtual scavenger hunt to teach students of the province about geoscience.

The event is part of PEGNL's festivities for National Engineering and Geosciences Month. In the spirit of accessibility, the scavenger hunt will be run through an app which can be downloaded onto phones or tablets and all "missions" can be submitted online through the app.

There will be prizes for the top 3 participants (\$500 for first place, \$200 for second and \$100 for third) and an additional \$100 prize given to one random participant who has completed at least one mission!

The winners will be announced April 3, 2020.

**Directions:**

- 1) Go to the Apple app store or Google Play store and download the "GooseChase" app for your phone or tablet.
- 2) Open the app and create your account.
- 3) Search for the game "PEGNL Geosciences Month Scavenger Hunt" or game code "4X3RDJ" and join up.
- 4) The password for the game is "PEGNL".
- 5) Wait for the game to go Live on March 16<sup>th</sup> at 12:01am.
- 6) Read through the missions list and get started!

**Additional Information:**

- You may find and join the game at any time, but the game will go live on March 16<sup>th</sup> at 12:01am (11:31pm on March 15<sup>th</sup> in Labrador). Missions will not be released until the game begins.
- The game will finish on March 31<sup>nd</sup> at 11:59pm (11:29pm in Labrador). All submissions must be made before this time.
- You may submit any answer or picture you wish for each mission, but moderators will be tracking the game and will remove incorrect answers. If an incorrect answer is removed, you will be able to redo that mission.
- The missions are a mix of text and photo answers.

- In the event of a tie at the end of the scavenger hunt, winner's names will be randomly drawn from those who place the highest. Total prize payout is \$900 divided into four prize categories.
- Feel free to post any of your pictures or answers to social media to help promote geosciences in the province. Just use the hashtag "#PEGNL" in your post, there might even be some bonus points in there for you!
