ENGINEERING AND GEOSCIENCE SCHOLARSHIPS

The PEGNL Engineering and Geoscience Scholarships are awarded to residents of Newfoundland and Labrador who have completed high school in this province and are attending Memorial University in an engineering or an earth science program. Engineering students must be enrolled in Term 1 or higher and earth science students must be enrolled in year 3 or higher of an honours earth science degree program.

Selection criteria shall include:

- High academic standing
- Superior language skills
- Financial need

The Scholarship for Excellence will be awarded to an engineering or geoscience student in the amount of \$5,000. It may be renewed for one year based on continuing high scholastic achievement. Additional selection criteria include:

- Adequate ability/performance in a second language (either English, French or a Native Aboriginal language of Newfoundland and Labrador);
- Demonstrated qualities of leadership and performance in sports, public speaking or related activities;

PEGNL General Scholarships are in the amount of \$2,500.00 each, and may be presented to an engineering student or an earth science student.

These scholarships are funded by contributions to the PEGNL Endowment Fund from Professional Engineers and Professional Geoscientists.

Applications will be received up to December 15, 2011 and must be accompanied by your most recent official transcript. Note: In completing this form, please elaborate on additional sheets, if necessary. PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE LEGIBLY.
